VINEYARD INFO / REGION

Our grapes are grown on the slopes of the original Rancho Tolenas, the Mexican Land Grant spanning Napa and Solano Counties. Located just east over the Vaca mountains from Napa Valley, the Suisun Valley is nicely situated to get both coastal breezes and plenty of direct sunshine. Our Sauvignon Blanc not only showcases the versatility of the grape itself but also how the AVA delivers on complex flavors and classic varietals.

WINEMAKING / VITICULTURE

The Sauvignon Blanc is one of our personal favorites. Long before Tolenas was even a dream, our family loved the fruit-forward Sauvignon Blancs that came from Suisun Valley vineyards. We loved the "atypical" flavor profiles of tropical fruit, beautiful citrus, cider, and floral elements. This cold fermented, 100% stainless steel Suisun Valley Sauvignon Blanc is bursting with aromatics.

TASTING NOTES

Our Sauvignon Blanc marries the zingy and intense nature of a New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc with a riper and rounder character often found in Napa wines. It manages to maintain great freshness and drive throughout. It's the perfect summer grilling wine for fish, chicken, or citrus-inspired salads.
